Tomorrow is the last official day of Term 1, as Monday to Thursday next week is designated to school development days. Staff will be preparing curriculum content for each year level and learning how this will be delivered digitally.

Parents and carers must keep their children at home unless they are required to travel to work. This will also be the case during Term 2 to minimise the potential spread of the COVID-19 virus.

The digital platform we will be using for home supported learning is Seesaw. Many of you are familiar with this program through its use as a communication tool in classes. If you are not familiar with Seesaw download the Family App for parents and the Class App for students. Once accounts have been established by the school you will be provided with the login details. More information on this to follow next week. Provisions will be made for those families who do not have access to the appropriate technology at home.

Students who need to attend school (according to the guidelines outlined above) from the commencement of Term 2 will be using Seesaw in the same way students will be at home to ensure equity across the student population.

Please be aware that the state of play during the COVID - 19 pandemic is ever changing and unpredictable. As a school, we continue to act upon the regular updates and advice provided by the Federal and State Governments, and the Education and Health Departments. We will continue to keep you informed as things progress.
