The Year Group Leader will be the main point of contact for the period of isolation. The classroom teacher will be cc'd into email communication between parents and the Year Group Leader.</i></p>	<p>Scenario 1: TEACHER IS AT SCHOOL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The teacher will continue with face-to-face teaching of students at school. • Students isolating at home will be provided with a matrix of activities to complete. • Students learning from home will be provided with links to learning activities. <p>Scenario 2: TEACHER IS ISOLATING AND WORKING FROM HOME (Asymptomatic)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teacher will provide students also isolating with learning activities. • An isolation matrix with activities will be uploaded for students to begin with. • A relief teacher will be employed to teach face to face to students attending school. <p>Scenario 3: TEACHER IS ISOLATING AND NOT WELL ENOUGH TO TEACH (Symptomatic)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A relief teacher will be employed for face-to-face teaching of students remaining at school. • If the teacher is not well the Year Group Leader will implement the <i>Learning from Home</i> plan • A matrix with activities will be uploaded for students to begin with. <p><i>A Year Group Leader will be the main point of contact for the period of isolation. The classroom teacher will be cc'd into email communication between parents and the Year Group Leader.</i></p>

Student isolating and unwell	Students who are unwell are not expected to participate in Learning from Home. Please contact the office on 9397 8300 by 9am so you child can be marked as unwell using the correct attendance code. They will be recorded as sick for the 7-day period.	
Students isolating and well enough to participate in Learning from Home	Students who are well enough in participate in Learning from Home will be marked as participating. If your child becomes unwell, please contact the office on 9397 8300 by 9am in order from the correct attendance code to be entered.	
Learning From Home Materials	If students do not have the necessary items to participate in Learning from Home, please contact the office on 9397 8300. An Associate Principal will contact you to assist with material where possible. Families who do not have access to online learning are to contact the school. An alternative learning option will be made available and will be left in a designated space for collection.
